COVID-19 Vaccine Beyond-Use Date/Time (BUD) Tracking Labels Pfizer 5-11 Monovalent BUD Vial Labels Instruction Sheet

The Philadelphia Department of Public Health (PDPH) has created vial labels for **Pfizer 5-11 Monovalent COVID-19** vaccine vials. These labels should be used to identify when a vial was first punctured and when it should be discarded.

Prior to using any vaccine, check the product expiration and beyond use date. **Never use expired vaccine. Never use vaccine after the beyond-use date or times.** Follow the instructions for each vaccine product to calculate the time the vial must be discarded.

Managing Your COVID-19 Vaccine Vials

- 1. Remove the vaccine vial from the refrigerator. Follow manufacturer preparation instructions.
- 2. Complete the information on the vial label. Record the lot number, name of staff person who first punctures the vial, and the date/time of the dilution.
- Pfizer orange cap COVID-19 vaccine may be stored at room temperature (33°F-77°F or 2°C-25°C) for up to 12 hours. Any vaccine remaining after 12 hours must be discarded (scan the orange QR code to access our Wastage Guide).
