

Patient Eligibility and Funding Source Guide

The purpose of this guide is to help you determine the funding sources that correspond with patient eligibility codes, which are determined by insurance status, age, and other factors.

Not VFC-Eligible	V00 – VFC eligibility undetermined or unknown		PCH70 – Privately-funded vaccine
	V01 – Not VFC eligible	Client does not qualify for VFC because they do not have one of the statuses: V02 – V05	
VFC-eligible	V02 – VFC eligible: Medicaid/ Medicaid Managed Care	All of the following are true: 1. Client is currently eligible for Medicaid or Medicaid managed care 2. Client is < 19 years old 3. The type of vaccine administered is eligible for VFC funding	VXC51 – Public VFC or PCH70 – Privately-funded vaccine
	V03 – VFC eligible: uninsured	All of the following are true: 1. Client does not have health insurance 2. Client is < 19 years old 3. The type of vaccine administered is eligible for VFC funding	
	V04 – VFC eligible: American Indian/Alaskan Native	All of the following are true: 1. Client is a member of a federally recognized tribe 2. Client is < 19 years old 3. The type of vaccine administered is eligible for VFC funding	
	V05 – VFC eligible: FWHC Patient (underinsured)	All of the following are true: 1. Client has insurance that partially covers vaccines received in visit 2. Client is receiving care at a Federally Qualified Health Center 3. Client is < 19 years old 4. The type of vaccine administered is eligible for VFC funding	
VFAAR	V23 – 317 VFAAR in Philadelphia	All of the following are true: 1. Client is ≥ 19 years of age 2. Client is eligible to receive vaccines under the state/program immunization policy 3. The vaccine administered is eligible for 317 funding	VXC52 – Public non-VFC
Other	V22 – CHIP	Client is eligible for the CHIP program, a separate state health insurance that is NOT a Medicaid expansion program	PCH70 – Privately-funded vaccine
	V24 – Medicare	Client is enrolled in Medicare
