### JAMES MORENO (15)


James grew up down the block from Derek in North Philly and goes to Strawberry Mansion High School. He plays soccer and he is being scouted to play professionally.




## FRIDA D'ALESSANDRA (17)

The anger that runs through me is like nothing I've ever felt before.


