

Accessing Your Immunization Record

The PhilaVax Public Portal lets people who got vaccines in Philadelphia view their vaccine records online. Parents and guardians can also access their minor children's records.

These are official vaccine records that you can save or print. You may need them for school, daycare, work, or travel.

You can download a PDF of your full vaccine record or your COVID-19 vaccine record with your SMART Health card.

How to access the PhilaVax Public Portal:

1. Go to the PhilaVax Public Portal: <https://myvaccines.phila.gov/>
 - a. You must be using Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, or Mozilla Firefox.
2. Click **Me** to view your personal record or click **Dependent** to view your child's record.
 - a. Only parents or guardians can access a minor's records.

3. Enter the legal first name, legal last name, date of birth (MM/DD/YYYY), and gender for the patient whose record is being searched.

4. Choose **Mobile Phone** or **Email** to get a verification code to access the vaccine record. Then, enter the phone number or email that you have on file with your health care provider. After that, click **Get Access Code**.

5. If the record is found, you will get a verification code to the contact method you chose (phone or email). Enter the code in the box, then click **Verify**.
 - a. Tip: Make sure that the name, date of birth, and cell phone or email that you enter is the same one you used at your doctor's office or pharmacy when you got the vaccine.

6. The immunization record will appear. There are options to download a full immunization record or a COVID-19-only record. Select the best option to view, save, or print the immunization record.

After 20 minutes of inactivity, you will automatically be redirected to the home page and will need to perform a search again. Please avoid downloading reports or files on public or shared computers. If you must use a public or shared device, delete all downloaded files and browser history after use.

Important Things to Note:

- The phone number or email you use must match the information your doctor gave to the Department of Public Health. For security reasons, it must be an exact match.
- Use your full legal name only. This is usually the name on your insurance card.
 - For example, if your name is Alexander but you go by Alex, enter Alexander as your first name.
- Parents or guardians can see vaccine records for children under 18.
- PhilaVax may not have all vaccine records. The system only shows information sent by doctors and clinics. If records are missing, contact your doctor's office for a full record.
